THE 57th Bedford Park Festival



The Bedford Park Festival (including its opening Green Days weekend) is one of London's bestloved arts and community events, attracting thousands of people of all ages. It involves many local artists, musicians and performers, professional and amateur and, with almost 20 events over two weeks,

there is something for everyone - art, crafts, photography, music, five-a-side football, poetry, talks, walks and children's and community events.

The Festival was established in 1967 by St Michael & All Angels Church, with the support of the Bedford Park Society, to celebrate the arts, raise money for repairs to the church and 'foster a spirit of friendliness and community'.

More than 50 years on, the Festival is still true to the spirit in which it was established. The Bedford Park Festival raises much needed funds every year for four different charities and the work of St Michael and All Angels. This year the charities are The Upper Room, which provides food, counselling and essential support to homeless people and ex-offenders in our local community; Swinfen Telemedicine, which helps medical professionals working in some of the most deprived communities to access leading specialists across the UK, Europe & North America; our new charity Crosslight Chiswick which provides face-to-face debt advice, together with money education and budgeting support, to individuals and families in need - and the St Michael & All Angels Trust, which gives grants to further the church's religious and pastoral work and supports the maintenance of its buildings.


